JANUARY 14 TO 22, SUNDAY TO MONDAY, NOVENA TO THREE AMERICAN SAINTS FOR LIFE: Saints Elizabeth Ann Seton, Frances Cabrini, and John Neumann are powerful witnesses to the Gospel of Life, each in their own time. This novena suggests three days of prayer to each of the saints for the promotion of life in our country and our Church today. Pray this novena along with us each day after the 3:00 PM EST Chaplet of Divine Mercy either in person at the National Centre for Padre Pio or via livestream on Facebook or YouTube.

FEBRUARY 12 TO MARCH 25, EACH MONDAY, SORROWFUL MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY

REFLECTION GROUP: Each session begins at 10:00 AM and concludes with the Rosary and Veneration of the Relic Glove of Padre Pio at 11:30 AM. This reflection group is comprised of seven powerful episodes that focus on the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary.
